

Big Spring school board adopts final budget with tax increase

The Big Spring school board adopted a \$40 million budget for the 2009-10 year at its meeting Monday.

The budget increases expenses from the tentative budget's \$39.9 million. It includes the same property tax increase, going to 15.514 mills from 14.72 mills, that was planned in the tentative budget.

The hike translates to a tax increase of \$79.40 for a property assessed at \$100,000, raising the annual bill to \$1,551.40 from \$1,472.

The budget includes a spending increase of about 4.7 percent over this year's budget.
