



# Annville-Cleona school taxes to increase 5.1 percent

Annville-Cleona School District residents will see a 5.1 percent school property tax increase under the 2009-10 school budget approved this week.

The school board on a 5-4 vote approved a \$19 million dollar budget that is \$212,000 less than this year's.

The reduction comes primarily from the loss of four teachers who are not being replaced, according to district business manager Mike Frentz.

The owner of a property assessed at the district average of \$20,018 will see a \$92.11 increase in real estate taxes, for a total bill of \$1786.97. The millage rate increases from 88.96 mills to 93.49. A mill equals \$1 per \$1,000 of assessed value.
